**Credit/Hours:** 1 Credit

## **Course Description:**

This course focuses on mastery of the Pennsylvania Academic Standards for Reading, Writing and Listening, with an emphasis on the Grade 7 Pennsylvania Academic Anchors for Reading. Throughout the year, the students will work on vocabulary development and the further development of basic reading, writing and higher level thinking skills.

Curriculum materials are derived from works of classic literature (myths, fables, folktales/legends), short stories, abridged and unabridged classics, historical fiction novels, biographies, autobiographies, poems, and non-fiction books and articles. In addition, students will complete basic reading exercises and vocabulary activities and compose written responses to articles. Students will also compose informative, persuasive and narrative writing pieces.
